#### **District level workshops for Authorized Officers**

- Conduct 6 workshops with the participation of District level officers attached to the RDHS divisions to plan the proposed Food Safety Week programme with the participation of
  - SPHI (D)s,
  - F&DIs,
  - HEOs,
  - REs,
  - RDHSs.

Formation of Food Safety Surveillance Committees at RDHS level.

- Formation of RDHS level Food Safety Surveillance Units.
- Establish 24 such Units through out the island.
  - RDHS(chair person of the Committee) other members-RE,MOMCH,F&DI,SPHID, MOH (3 nominated by the committee), SPHII (3 nominated by the committee)
  - These Committees should be meet at least quarterly to monitor the Food safety activities conducted within the district.

#### **Organize Island wide activities**

- Inspection of Food Handling Establishments on 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> of October 2009.
  - All the MOOH,SPHII(D),PHII,F&DII,HEOO,REs are required to serve as a team on the above three days.
- Conduct seminars for Food handlers , Consumer Societies.

# Island wide visits by central level health staff

- Visit Provincial Health Office under a pre-arrange programme, discus with PDHS,RDHS,F&DII,SPHIID.
- Observe the activities planed by the staff, conduct evaluations, attend to seminars organized by the field staff.
- Meet relevant Government and Non Governmental officials and Consumer Organizations.

Conduct meetings with Food Importers/Exporters/Manufacturers and device a system to supply quality food products.

 Conduct one day programme for Importers/Exporters/Manufactu rers with the participation of the Hon. Minister of Health.

## Printing and distribution of Food Regulations in a book format.

 Food Regulations published in a reference hand book format and distributed to Authorized Officers and other relevant agencies.

#### Formation of Risk Assessment of Core Group

- Establish a mechanism to provide risk assessment advice to the Provincial and Municipality Health Authorities on Food Hygiene.
- Appointment of an Assessment team /committee of experts to provide scientific advice on microbiological risk assessment.
- Assessment team of the Ministry to visit all 9 Provinces and to examine current system and status.
- > Develop a master plan based on the findings.
- Establish a mechanism to provide risk assessment advice to the Provincial Health Authorities on Food Hygiene
