- **Making informational , educational materials on poisoning and distribution**
- **Planning preventive activities**
 - 1) To keep all household products, other chemicals , pesticides, and medicines locked up and out of sight.
 - 2) When products are in use, never let young children out of your sight. Take the child or product with when answering the phone or doorbell.
 - 3) Keep products in the containers they came in.
 - 4) Leave product in the containers they came in.
 - 5) Stop easy access to pesticides for the public.
- **Taking coordinated action with other stake holders**

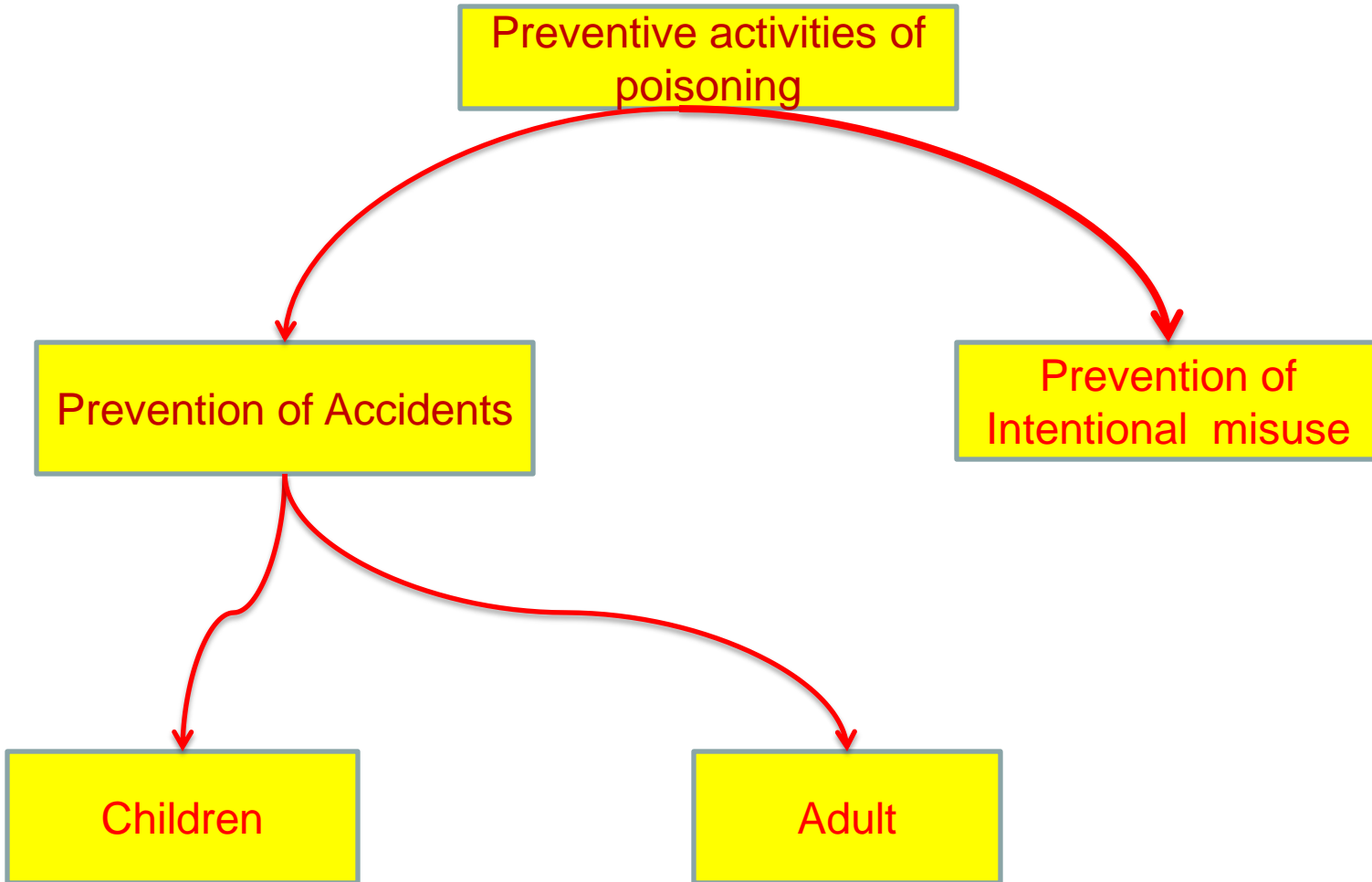
