Module content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Familiarize with speech audiometric materials. • Practice presentation of speech material- monitored live voice and recorded. • Observe and record speech audiometry (SAT, SRT, SRS, MCL, UCL) of 10 clients. • Observe biological calibration of audiometers and prepare a correction chart. • Perform daily visual and listening check of audiometers. • Observe, record and interpret Immittance test. • Observe and record ABR test. • Observe and record BOA, CPA and VRA. • Observe HAT and HA counseling. • Observe post assessment counseling.
