1. List differences between Nephritic Syndrome and Nephrotic Syndrome.
2. List features that would suggest a non minimal histology in Nephrotic Syndrome.
3. The child is commenced on daily prednisolone therapy. How would you determine whether she has steroid sensitive or resistant Nephrotic Syndrome?
4. What complications can she develop during the acute stage of the disease?

She responded to steroid therapy and later she presented with several relapses over a period of time. She is found to be steroid dependent.

5. Describe the different management options available.
6. While in the ward for a relapse she develops severe abdominal pain. List 5 possible causes.
