- Publish at least two articles based on the research in Science Citation Indexed journals.

2. Cover letter, indicating the motivation for your choice and area of relevant research area you are interested in. Discuss your skills adapted to the selected topic. When possible, to support your arguments, indicate reference persons (Name / Institution / Email) who could agree to recommend you for the PhD.
3. Copy of certificate of undergraduate degree in medicine or allied health sciences (preferably with a class)
4. Work experience certificates, if applicable
