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The Journey of "Carlo Rachitha Gee – Weda Sisu Hadin"

aculty of Medicine, University of Kelaniya is one of the leading medical faculties in Sri Lanka celebrating its 30th Anniversary in 2021. Among the many events organized in parallel to the 30th Anniversary, the Finale Event – "Carlo Rachitha Gee – Weda Sisu Hadin" was a glamorous event that paid tribute to the founder Dean of the Faculty, Prof Carlo Fonseka.

Prof. Carlo Fonseka is a renowned personality not only in medicine but also in medical teaching, research, art, literature, politics and administration. The contribution made by this eminent figure toward the field of Art as a literary critic, a lyricist, and as a composer are truly remarkable. The bond between Prof Carlo and the Faculty of Medicine, Ragama is inseparable and unique.

The story of the show "Carlo Rachitha Gee-Weda Sisu Hadin" goes back to July 2021 Written by Evin Gamage

when Prof. Anurudhdhi Edirisinghe came up with the concept of paying tribute to our Founder Dean with songs penned by him. Preparation for the event began with by Mr K. A. K. Kodithuwakku, Coordinator of the Cultural Center, and Evin Gamage, President of the Art Society of the Faculty of Medicine, who took on the responsibility of coordination and production of the event.

Subsequently, research for songs written by Prof. Carlo started. The original tracks were found with the help of The Sri Lanka Broadcasting Corporation. Then the students along with Prof. Edirisinghe and Mr. Kodithuwakku had several discussions to choose the most fitting songs for the event. Discussions were carried out with the family of Prof Carlo and the original artists to obtain permission to use the songs and for the possibly doing some alterations to the songs.



The orchestra was formed under the leadership of Dr. Ravindu Pieris. Owing to the strict COVID-19 guidelines the initial practices and musical notation preparations were done online.

The orchestra and the choir consisted entirely of graduate doctors and current students from MBBS and SHS Batches of the faculty. On-site practices for the event started in January adhering to prevalent COVID-19 guidelines. Most practices were held during the weekends as it was convenient for participating students and doctors. Practice sessions were exciting as it was an opportunity for the students to get together and do something they were passionate about. Due to the pandemic, there had been a long pause in extracurricular activities in the faculty and this was a great opportunity for past and present students to showcase their talent and strengthen bonds between them. The orchestra consisted of 4 guitarists, 4 violinists, 1 saxophonist, 1 drummer, 1 percussionist, and 3 keyboard players. The choir consisted of 33 vocalists led by the Choir Master Vishan Lahiru Palliyaralalage. Dance performances were by students of the faculty and choreography was arranged by Vishan Lahiru Palliyaralalage.

Since our focus was paying tribute to Prof. Fonseka, we decided to create a new song tas well. Prof Darshana Rathnayake wrote the lyrics for the song "Mahaduru Carlo" and music composition was done by Jishal Avishka Gnanarathna. Prof. Anurudhdhi Edirisinghe suggested that we make two new symphonies as well, to make the event more colorful. This challenge was taken up by Dr. Ravindu Pieris and Jishal Gnanarathna who came up with two marvelous musical creations, much admired and commended by many. The seven chosen songs written by Prof. Carlo were also modulated with permission by adding various vocal and instrumental pieces to spice them up.











The event preparations were done along with the 30th Anniversary Committee which was led by Minura Laksith. With the COVID-19 regulations as well as the prevailing weather conditions we had to make several changes and finally 25th of March was decided as the best day for the event. A live broadcast of the event via YouTube was also planned. Many changes were done to the stage setting of the Main Examination Hall to make the event more vibrant. Students also made digital animations for the two LED panels which were a visual treat for the audience.









The participation of many eminent figures in the field of art and music was a new experience for the faculty. Visharadha Sunil Edirisinghe, Visharadha Edward Jayakody, and Ms Subhani Amaradeva (on behalf of Pandith Amaradeva) sang along with our choir and orchestra. They talked of their experiences and memories of Prof Carlo Fonseka, too. Dr Rohana Weerasinghe guided the students during practice sessions. Prof Sunil Ariyarathne delivered a critique on Prof Carlo Fonseka's work which was one of the most enjoyable sessions of the day. The event was magnificently conducted with much musical and academic nobility. There were many distinguished figures present such as Senior Prof Janaki Hewavisenthi, Dean, Faculty of Medicine, Prof Kapila Gunathilake, Secretary, Ministry of Buddha Sasana, Religious and Cultural Affairs, Prof Sudath Kalingamudali, Dean, Faculty of Science,

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

He represented the University of Kelaniya at the 12th UiTM International Sports Fiesta held in Malaysia. The International University Day celebrations was a glamorous

event with many events, including the article challenge, football juggling challenge and IDUS sports quiz 2021. IDUS 2021 held as a virtual session was attended by over 700 participants. The panel discussion moderated by Kaveendra with elite panelists in the calibre of Prof.

The recently concluded WESPA (World Kaveendra English Language Scrabble Players Association) Championship 2021 was held from the 20th of November to the 5th of December 2021. WESPAC witnesses the participation of top players from member countries. This year the tournament was hosted by Pakistan and, owing to the Covid-19 pandemic, was conducted online. 120 participants from more than 25 countries qualified to play based on a quota system offered to each country, after which the national association decided on who qualified to represent the country.

Janidu Karunarathne, a student from the 30th Batch of the Faculty of Medicine, and the 9th highest rated player in the country, qualified to represent Sri Lanka along with 5 others.
