Get to Know Your Library

The Medical Library of the University of Kelaniya was established in 1991, based on the foundation laid by the library of the North Colombo Medical College (NCMC). The library's main objective is to fulfill the information needs of academic staff and students of the Faculty of Medicine by providing information resources required for the educational and research programs of the faculty.

Library Services

The Medical Library offers a wide range of services catering to its users' diverse needs.

- Lending Services: The Library provides convenient access to library materials and lending services for all users via an organized and efficient circulation system.
- Reference Services: Library reference services are designed to help users find the resources they need and the answers they seek via specialized services.
- Document Delivery Service (DDS): The Library offers the Document Delivery Service (DDS) for students and staff of the faculty. Students and staff could request full-text articles and book chapters not available in the Library via this service. You may fill out the DDS Request Form online or send your request to the Library via Email: <u>libmed@kln.ac.lk</u>
- Current Awareness Services: Users are informed the new resources, new additions and new services introduced to the library via e-mail, Notices and Memos.
- Information Literacy Instruction: Library conduct workshops, webinars and one-to-one sessions to teach users how to search information efficiently, and cite information accurately. One-to-one sessions on Database Searching are conducted on request.
- Reader Advisory Service: Library handles various user queries on information and provides proper guidance to users.
- Virtual Reference Services: In addition to in-person assistance, library offer virtual reference services. These services enable users to seek guidance remotely through email.

Online Catalog (OPAC)

All Library books and other resources, including Postgraduate Theses, Research Reports, and bound Journals available in the library, can be searched via the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC).

Past Paper Repository

This repository archives all Past papers of the University of Kelaniya's MBBS, SHS, and Occupational Therapy Examinations.

E-Books & Journals

The library provides online access to over one thousand book titles and journals via ProQuest EBook Central Book Database, Oxford University Press Journals & Oxford Medicine Online Books platforms, EBSCOHost Database & Traylor Francis Books and Journals Platform.

Research4Life

Research4Life provides free or low-cost online access to leading journals and books in the fields of health, agriculture, environment, applied sciences, and legal information.

Research papers and conference abstracts published by the faculty staff members and postgraduate theses.
